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Some Changes to Small Steps

We are always looking at ways to improve the physical environment that the children experience every day. As part of our long-term improvement plan, we will be making some changes to the Butterflies area to give them free flow between their room and the eating/ messy area. This will enable them more space to play and enjoy greater choice in their activities.

We will also be resurfacing some areas of the garden. We are replacing two large planters and also safety surfacing under the sheltered area.

There is also the possibility of replacing the flooring in Bumble Bees room and the bathroom in the autumn term.
